Author Event: **Laurie Halse Anderson October 22, 2008 6:00 p.m.**

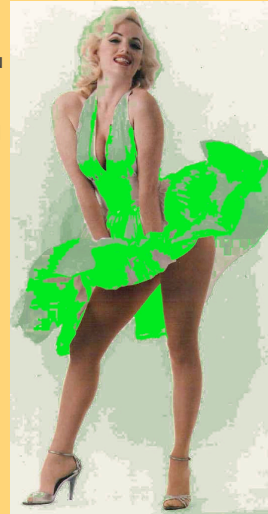
