What's New?

\*Linden Hills Co-op is trying to raise the remaining \$500,000 of the \$1.5 million it needs from its members to help finance the move to Sunnyside and France. The full amount must be raised by January 31.

What's Next?

\*Some Co-op members are objecting to the planned move, saying it's not in the best interest of the neighborhood or the store. They've organized a public conversation on *Thursday January 21 at 7pm* at Linden Hills Park building.

\*If the relocation moves forward, the store will remain open at 43rd and Upton through the summer. When the new location at Sunnyside and France is ready, the current store will close and the new one will open 3 days later.
